



The **Fireside Apartments** in **Mill Valley** provide permanent, supportive housing for low-income families and seniors. Homeward Bound of Marin partners with Eden Housing, the property manager, to coordinate services for residents of the 50-unit community that include a food pantry, outings and community celebrations, ridesharing and referral to other local services.

Volunteer Opportunities:

Visit a Senior: Some of our seniors love to connect with people one-on-one, have tea, and talk about life. Would you like to become a friend who visits a senior once a week for an hour that will brighten someone's day?

Pantry Assistants: The pantry opens twice a month on-site from 9:45am to noon. We distribute food to families and seniors living at Fireside Apartments. You'll help organize the produce, bag it and hand it out to our residents.

Kiddie Corner / Bingo Evening Helpers: You can love both sides of our amazing community – seniors and kids – with an hour spent overseeing the fun in our Kiddie Corner followed by an hour of bingo with our seniors. The shift includes a half-hour of cleanup and setup in the community room.
