Volunteer Opportunity:

Housing Coordinator -- We're looking for a special volunteer to support residents in pursuing housing opportunities. You will introduce options for subsidized, shared and independent housing and help them with various steps:

- Identify potential barriers to housing.
- Gather required documents for housing application (rental history, references, etc.)
- Get credit reports and find credit repair advice, if needed.
- Review housing opportunities listed online.
- Contact landlords/managers about housing opportunities.
- Prepare to introduce themselves to prospective landlords.

We're seeking someone with experience/understanding in these areas:

- Working with homeless individuals and people with very low income
- Helping people with Axis 1 mental health diagnoses
- Building rapport with diverse personalities
- Knowledge of the Marin area and various housing options

You will work as part of a staff team that offers in-house support around the clock for this residential program.
