Shifts available: Fridays 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. or Sundays 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

This is an excellent opportunity to learn about and play a practical role in resolving the issue of homelessness by providing direct assistance to residents and staff. We are looking for people who will have a regular weekly role in our programs.

Working under the supervision of program staff, volunteers will have a range of responsibilities:

- Meet and welcome residents into the facility
- Answer phones and take messages for staff
- Give bus tickets to residents
- Cover front desk during staff meetings or breaks
- Accurately perform regular office tasks

Qualifications: We are looking for volunteers who are organized, reliable, kind, and approachable. Volunteers need good communication skills, a commitment to confidentiality and the ability to exercise professional boundaries. Familiarity with local resources or an interest in learning about them will be beneficial.
