Our goal is to build 50 homes by 2025 to celebrate 50 years of serving the Marin community.



## WHO WE ARE

Homeward Bound of Marin has served the Marin community for over 50 years by helping people stabilize and set goals for the future, secure long-term housing, access healthcare and mental health supports, pursue educational or career goals and retain employment.



## JOIN US TO CREATE NEW HOUSING AND TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES IN MARIN

Homeward Bound is building affordable housing for veterans, families, and chronically homeless adults on the site of the former Hamilton Army Airfield in Novato. This project will end veteran homelessness in our community, making Marin the second county in California to reach this important goal. Three Mission-style buildings will complete a housing and training hub

- 24 one-bedroom apartments for unhoused veterans to have a “forever home”.
- 26 apartments for families and adults transitioning out of homelessness.
- A manufacturing bakery and culinary training center to expand Homeward Bound’s job training, supportive employment and social enterprise businesses.

Homeward Bound's culinary-focused social enterprises offer skill-building opportunities and provide good-paying jobs with support services to help people break through employment barriers. Revenue from these businesses is reinvested in housing, job training, and supportive employment for people confronted by insufficient income and housing instability. This project will create a new educational center and manufacturing bakery, providing much-needed room for our training and employment programs to grow.

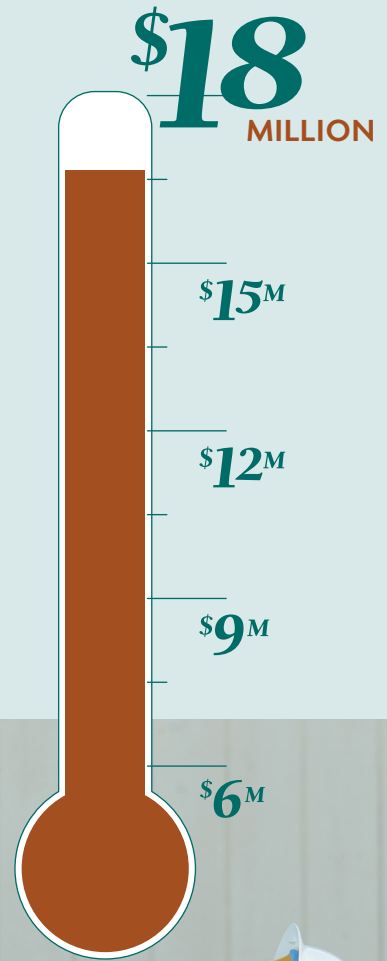
