

Volunteer Opportunity: Kids' Activities/Childcare Support

Oma Village is a community of 14 homes that provides permanent supportive housing for

families who have experienced homelessness. The program offers opportunities for families to build resilience, connect with their community, and access support from onsite staff as they work toward long-term stability.

As part of the program, parents and staff hold monthly meetings to share experiences, discuss community matters, and learn about resources in Marin. We are seeking one or more volunteers to lead activities and provide supervision for children during these meetings.



Volunteer Role:

Volunteers will lead activities like art projects or games while parents attend the meetings. Depending on how many volunteers participate, children can be divided into groups. The age range is 3 to 14 years old.

Volunteers will take charge of organizing activities and Homeward Bound will provide any materials needed. Staff will be present onsite but engaged in other responsibilities.

Time Commitment:

2nd Wednesday of each month from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m.

Qualifications:

We are seeking adult leaders (18+ years old), who enjoy working with children of all ages. These lead adults can bring 2 to 3 youth (age 15+) to support these activities. Spanish language skills or experience with teaching or camp-style activities is helpful.
