



Volunteer Opportunity: Meal Server at Jonathan's Place

Our Jonathan's Place building in San Rafael is the county's only year-round emergency shelter for adults facing homelessness. The shelter provides 38 beds for people transitioning toward housing with case management, meals and help to access benefits or community resources.

We are looking for individuals or teams of two as servers for the evening meal. This project offers a tangible way to help provide nourishment and connection for diners while learning about our housing-focused services.

Working with supervision from onsite staff, servers are responsible for:

- Meal set-up and light food prep
- Standing at a service counter and moving during the shift
- Knowing basic cooking and kitchen safety skills
- Using knives and kitchen equipment safely
- Lifting or carrying food or supplies (25 lbs. or more)
- Reliability and respect with staff and diners

Volunteers must be 16 years and older.
